# Foundation Grant Programme

# CG Jung Foundation Zürich

### Objective

Grants from the CG Jung Foundation Zürich are intended to support the training of analytical candidates enrolled at an international Jungian Institute.

- The Foundation aids individuals who can demonstrate both financial need, brought about by a crisis situation, and the ability and commitment to complete study in the field of Jungian training leading to membership of the IAAP.
- The Foundation is looking to support individuals who, upon graduation, have the
  capacity and local clinical credentials to practice Jungian analysis in either private and/or
  public mental health work settings.

#### Who is eligible for a grant?

Diploma/advanced candidates following their Institute programme leading to membership of the IAAP upon graduation.

#### What is financial need?

Candidates who can demonstrate a significant personal financial need due to sudden unexpected circumstances.

#### Grants

A fixed number of annual grants of up to \$5000 to cover the fees for one semester will be planned each year and paid directly to the Institute attended.

#### **Exceptional Grant**

An exceptional grant of up to \$1000 is available to Diploma/advanced candidates where unexpected events mean they would otherwise fail to finish their studies.

This will also be paid directly to the Institute attended.

#### **Duration of the Grant**

Each grant submission will cover a single year's funding. Previously supported candidates and unsuccessful applicants are eligible to reapply in subsequent years and will follow the same process as new applicants. There is no prescribed limit to the number of times a candidate may resubmit.

### The grant is a gift, not a loan

However, we encourage voluntary repayment, by inviting the successful candidate to contribute to the Foundation over the five years following graduation.

#### **Application Requirements**

### 1. Cover sheet candidate details

- Funding request: Specifically describe what has suddenly changed in life that is out of your control, that impacts your income and results in significant personal financial hardship, and how you plan to be able to continue to finance your training.
  - Examples: drastic fall in currency value, war or conflict interrupting life and the economy, family illness or death, or other issues of this magnitude.
- o *Note*: The grant is not to be considered part of one's financial planning to cover the costs of training.
